## Old Mill Shop APPLICATION – Page 2 Volunteer Participation

Volunteers are critical to the success of the Old Mill Shop and important to the quality of the consignors' experience at this venue. Although craft or retail experience can be helpful, it is not necessary for Mill volunteers. There are tasks available at different skill levels. People who have previously consigned goods at the Mill are especially encouraged to volunteer due to their general familiarity and previous experience with the Mill and similar craft show operations.

## Special Credits for Consignors Who Volunteer

We need volunteers who can work before, during and after the fair (see options below). Volunteers who work a minimum of 4 hours before or during the fair receive free 1-day admission ticket to the fair in addition to a volunteer badge that covers the day of their shift.

\*\*NEW\*\* <u>Consignors</u> are also entered into a **lottery drawing** for a **full refund of their application fee**, and they will receive special signage that calls attention to their work during the event. Consignors who supply additional volunteers will be entered in the <u>drawing once for</u> <u>each extra volunteer that they sign up</u>.
